This course is aimed at EYFS teachers and managers. It is created as four progressive sessions throughout the academic year.

The Early Years framework is set to change in 2021. Out of all the Early Learning Goals, mathematics has seen the biggest changes. The outcome of the course will be exemplification for the new ELG with the schools involved having their own 'Ages and Stages' descriptors for maths along with examples of what that could look like. Delegates will contribute to the exemplification through evidence of their own children's mathematics.

Other aims of this course are to equip teachers in the EYFS with how to:

- understand the two ELGs of Number and Numerical Patterns in depth
- create meaningful mathematical experiences, both in provision and teacher led
- make natural links within and between the Mathematics ELG and the other areas of learning and ELGs
- Develop a sense of what the revised 'Development Matters' will contain
